 Origanum majorana (oh-rih-GAY-num may-jor-AY-nah)

 TENDER PERENNIAL I LAMIACEAE FAMILY

 ZONES: 7-11

 EXPOSURE: FULL SUN

 MATURE HEIGHT: 12-18" I SPREAD 18-24"

 BLOOM: WHITE I SUMMER



Sweet Marjoram, or "Knotted" Marjoram, is a popular and versatile culinary herb with a sweeter, milder flavor than Oregano. Loves full sun and will not tolerate wet feet. Ensure soil is dry to the touch before watering thoroughly.

- Culinary: use in Mediterranean soups and sauces, on beef, salads, and pizzas.
- Therapeutic*: antiseptic, antispasmodic, carminative, cholagogue, diaphoretic, diuretic, emmenagogue, expectorant, stimulant, stomachic and mildly tonic.
- Used externally to treat muscular pain, bronchial complaints, arthritis, sprains and stiff joints.
