Artemisia annua (ar-tem-EE-zee-ah)

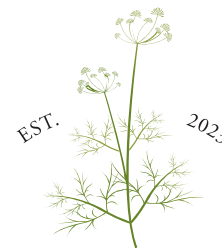

Artemisia 'Sweet Annie' is an aromatic annual that will scent your whole yard! Growing up to six feet tall, Sweet Annie self seeds profusely. Once used as a natural air freshener, it was kept hanging in pantries to repel insects. Don't overwater.

- Its feathery, fern-like foliage is often used in dried flower arrangements.
- Therapeutic*: seeds and leaves were used for a tea to treat colds and fevers. As an external poultice, it can reduce the symptoms of boils and abscesses. For thousands of years Qing Hao or Artemisinin was used in China as an antimalarial plant.
- A natural pesticide and insect deterrent, it will keep the gnats and other pests away all summer.
