Formerly Stachys officinalis, Betony is also known as Bishop's Wort, Wood Betony or Woundwort. This drought-resistant wildflower in the mint family is easy to grow.

- Known as a general cure for many varying ailments: migraines, neuralgia, wounds, tension, circulation.
- Therapeutic\*: anthelmintic, antiseptic, astringent, carminative, mildly cathartic, cholagogue, digestive, diuretic, mildly emetic, emmenagogue, expectorant, nervine, sedative, tonic and vulnerary.
- Use leaves and flowers fresh or dried in tea, tinctures and decoctions. Makes a nice caffeine free substitute for black tea <u>Caution</u>: consult a doctor if pregnant or nursing.
