

BURN JELLY PLANT Bulbine frutescens

SUCCULENT I ASPHODELACEAE FAMILY ZONES: 9-12 EXPOSURE: FULL SUN I OVERWINTER INDOORS MATURE HEIGHT: 18" I SPREAD 24" BLOOM: YELLOW I MID-SUMMER-LATE FALL





Sometimes called first aid plant, this South African native is a succulent that will overwinter on a bright indoor windowsill but can spend summers outside in full sun where it will attract pollinators. Its flower stalks tower up to 2 feet and feature yellow and orange star-shaped blooms.

- Therapeutic\*: antiseptic and haemostatic, promotes wound healing.
- Squeeze gel from the leaves and use topically for for burns, rashes, blisters, bites, chapped lips, cold sores and sunburn. Similar properties to aloe.
- Some studies show benefits for treating eczema and arthritis and acne.
